Thomas DACOSTA KAUFMANN is Frederick Marquand Professor of Art and Archaeology, Princeton University. Author of over 250 articles and reviews and of thirteen books, and editor of five more, he has received many honors and prizes, including honorary doctorates from universities in Brno and Dresden. He is a fellow of the Swedish, Flemish, and Polish Academies, and of the American Academies in Rome and Berlin. In addition to his long-standing interests in Central Europe, he has written on the geography and historiography of art, and questions of humanism, art, and science.
