

Emanuel CONȚAC (Ph.D. in Philology from the University of Bucharest) studied Theology. He is an associate professor at the Theological Pentecostal Institute of Bucharest, where he teaches Biblical Greek, Biblical Hermeneutics and The Rhetoric of 1 Corinthians.

Since 2015 he has chaired the panel of biblical scholars entrusted with the task of revising the Cornilescu Bible (revised edition of the EDCR NT published in 2019; the Pentateuch published online in 2021). He is also a founding member of the focus groups for Biblical Hebrew and Coptic at New Europe College.

Conțac has authored three books and more than 30 scholarly papers. Topmost among his research interests is the 450-year history of translating the Bible into Romanian.
