



Tarciziu-Hristofor ȘERBAN (b. 1962, in Bacău) is a Catholic priest; he is teaching Biblical sciences at the Faculty of Roman-Catholic Theology of the University of Bucharest. He specialized in Biblical exegesis at the Catholic Institute in Paris, as well as in the history of ancient Christianity at the University of Sorbonne in Paris and in philosophy at the University of Bucharest.

Alongside several studies in all these fields, he published his doctoral thesis *Military Metaphor in the Bible* at the „Alexandru Ioan Cuza” University Press in Iași (2011; he also authored two important books: *Iluzie și Libertate (Romani 1 – 8)*, in 2020, and *Viața împlinită (Romani 9 – 16)*, in 2021, within the collection *Universe of the Bible*, nos 3 and 4 at the Printing House of the Catholic Archbishopric of Bucharest. Together with Cristina Mareș, he also published *The Prophet of the Servant of God (Isaia 40–55)*, no 5 of the above mentioned collection. From the beginning he has been working for the project of the Romanian translation of the Bible from Hebrew at New Europe College, translating, writing introductory materials and exegetical notes.
