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His research interests mainly lie in the field of political theory, and are focused on electoral policies, democratic theory, democratic erosion and resilience, democratic innovations, and theories of justice. He has published two single-authored monographs, two co-edited volumes and one co-edited monograph, and around 25 articles and book chapters in prestigious international journals (e.g. *Journal of Politics*, *Political Studies*, *Political Research Quarterly*, *Contemporary Politics*, *European Journal of Political Theory*) and collective volumes (e.g. with *Oxford University Press*, *Routledge*, *Wiley-Blackwell*).
