

Alexandru Volacu is an Associate Professor at the Faculty of Business and Administration, the University of Bucharest, where he teaches a range of classes within the areas of governance, public policies, critical thinking, and academic integrity. From 2025 he is supervising PhD students in the field of Administrative Sciences, and is coordinating the MA Program *Public Policy for Energy, Climate Change, and Sustainability*. He has a PhD in Political Science from SNSPA and has been a NEC-Ameropa Fellow in 2022-2023. He is currently a Lead Researcher in the *Participatory Democracy that Scales* Horizon Europe-funded project, coordinated by the University of Groningen, where he is particularly involved in the study of digital democratic inclusion. He has previously been involved in several international research teams (e.g. in H2020 projects and COST Actions) and national research teams (including as Director in two UEFISCDI research grants).

His research interests mainly lie in the field of political theory, and are focused on electoral policies, democratic theory, democratic erosion and resilience, democratic innovations, and theories of justice. He has published two single-authored monographs, two co-edited volumes and one co-edited monograph, and around 25 articles and book chapters in prestigious international journals (e.g. *Journal of Politics, Political Studies, Political Research Quarterly, Contemporary Politics, European Journal of Political Theory*) and collective volumes (e.g. with *Oxford University Press, Routledge, Wiley-Blackwell*).
